

# Everything is by Allah Project Overview

## About the Project:

*Teaching our children to see the world through the lens of the Quran. So that they learn about Allah and fall in love with Him. Jumping to His worship, and they long to see Him.*

Explore our solar system and planet earth, with its different landscapes, animals, plants - through the lens of seven Names of Allah and six related (part) ayahs from the Quran (two of the names are Ar Rahman, Ar Raheem and are mentioned within one ayah chosen for the project).

Internalise how everything is by Allah. He created everything, owns and has control over each thing, guides it, and is the provider of all. Focus upon the feelings of love and mercy through the names Ar Rahman, Ar Raheem and Al Wadood.

## Project Resources:

- **Illustrated Poster:** showing two children in their garden looking at the world and outer space. On the left they see the Amazon Rainforest with its layers and cacao trees. In the middle is a European farm, variety of fruits and veg growing, wheat fields and a river. On the right is the Rocky Mountains and a beautiful lake-front masjid. Above them is the sun, moon, planets and Milky Way.
- **Six Names of Allah Flashcards:** for Al Malik, Al Khaaliq, Ar Razzaq, Al Haadi, Al Wadood, Ar Rahman & Ar Raheem with related (part) ayah to be printed on the reverse side.
- **33 main Flashcards:** categorised into six (part) ayahs in line with ayahs above, exploring different parts of the poster.
- **A resource made later – 3 dua flashcards:** refer to 'Group 7' below
- **A resource made later - a miscellaneous flashcard:** refer to 'Group 7' below

**Print the Names of Allah hearts on one side of the flashcard:**

- Al Malik
- Al Khaaliq
- Ar Razzaq
- Al Haadi
- Al Wadood
- Ar Rahman, Ar Raheem

**Print the related (part) ayah on the reverse side of the flashcard**

Note: The Names of Allah hearts and ayahs are colour coordinated.

# Group 1 Double-sided Flashcards

**Print the following illustrations on one side:**

- To Allah belongs the Sun.
- To Allah belongs the Moon.
- To Allah belongs the planets.
- To Allah belongs the Milky Way.
- To Allah belongs the Rocky Mountains.
- To Allah belongs our house.

**Print the ayah on the reverse side:**

وَلِلَّهِ مُلْكُ السَّمَوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضِ ۗ

And to Allah belongs the dominion of the heavens and the earth,

وَاللَّهُ عَلَىٰ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

and Allah has power over all things.

- Allah created the Amazon rainforest with all of its layers.

- Allah created the scarlet macaw and so many colourful creatures.
- Allah created the jaguar.
- Allah (indirectly) created the aeroplane. (Group 2 extra)
- Allah created the rivers, the seas and all water. (Group 2 extra)
- Allah created me. (Group 2 extra)

- Allah provides us with fruit and vegetables from different plants.
- Allah provides us with wheat needed for bread, pasta and more.
- Allah provides different homes for everyone.
- Allah provides the howler monkey leaves to eat.
- Allah provides the seeds.

**Print the ayah on the reverse side:**

إِنَّ اللَّهَ هُوَ الرَّزَّاقُ

Print the following illustrations on one side:

- Allah guides the bees to make honey.
- Allah guides us to reflect on His Signs.
- Allah guides us to du'a.
- Allah guides us with the Quran.
- Allah guides the Canadian geese to food.
- Allah guides the pronghorn antelope to water.

Print the ayah on the reverse side:

قَالَ رَبُّنَا الَّذِي أَعْطَى كُلَّ شَيْءٍ خَلْقَهُ ثُمَّ هَدَىٰ

He said, "Our Lord is He who gave each thing its form and then guided [it]."

## Print the following illustrations on one side:

- Allah loves the believers who follow the Prophet salAllahu alayhi wa sallam, for example by reflecting on His signs.
- Allah loves those who purify themselves.
- From Allah's mercy and love, He guides the believers to the straight path.

## Print the ayah on the reverse side:

إِنَّ رَبِّيَ رَحِيمٌ وَدُودٌ

Verily, my Lord is Most Merciful, Most Loving.

Print the following illustrations on one side:

- From Allah's mercy the bird cares for her young.
- From Allah's mercy the duck cares for her young.
- From Allah's mercy He made the world so beautiful.

Print the ayah on the reverse side:

وَإِلَهُكُمْ إِلَهٌ وَاحِدٌ

And your god is one God.

## **Print the following:**

- Illustration on one side: Jannah is going to be far more beautiful.  
Dua on reverse side: asking for Jannah and protection from the Fire
- Illustration on one side: I love Allah  
Dua on reverse: related to love
- Illustration on one side: I want to see Allah  
Dua on reverse: related to seeing Allah

## Group 7 Double-Sided Flashcards cont.

*A 'miscellaneous' flashcard was made to aid explaining how Allah Al Khaaliq (a name taught in this project) created everything, and He is above all He created, above His arsh. He is The King (another name taught in this project) who owns and has power over the mulk of the heavens and the earth, and He is above it and above His arsh.*

**Print the following illustrations on one side:**

Allah created the heavens and the earth in six days and rose over His throne.

**Print this on the reverse side:**

إِنَّ رَبَّكُمْ اللَّهُ الَّذِي خَلَقَ السَّمَوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضَ فِي سِتَّةِ أَيَّامٍ ثُمَّ اسْتَوَىٰ عَلَى الْعَرْشِ

Indeed, your Lord is Allāh, who created the heavens and earth in six days and then established Himself above the Throne.

# Reflection preceding this project

It's so amazing to contemplate on the extent to which Allah takes care of you, the extent to which your life, everything you see around you, the entire universe is because of Allah.

From His actions alone, only by Him (tawhid ar-rububiyah) the whole planet and universe exists, functions, lives, grows and thrives.

There is no place you can look, except it is by Allah.
